<sup>\*</sup>Withdrawal – If you are enrolled in a course/courses as of the first day of the \*term and you decide not to attend, you are withdrawing from the term. A withdrawal will result in a grade of "W" and a percentage, if not all, tuition will be owed depending on the effective withdrawal date.

<sup>\*</sup>Term – Please be aware there are several parts of term for the summer. Maymester, 1st 5 week, 2nd 5 week and the 10 week term are each considered individual terms.
